Boil water advisory lifted for Saint-Bruno-de-Montarville

Saint-Bruno-de-Montarville, **September 4**, **2023** – The City of Saint-Bruno-de-Montarville confirms that the boil water advisory in effect on its territory since September 1 has now been lifted, effective today, September 4, at 3:30 p.m.

The tests carried out on the network over the last 48 hours, in accordance with the rules laid down by the Public Health Department, show that the water is fit for consumption.

Residents no longer need to boil their water before consumption.
