## Boil water advisory lifted for Saint-Bruno-de-Montarville

**Saint-Bruno-de-Montarville, April 19, 2024** – The City of Saint-Bruno-de-Montarville confirms that the boil water advisory in effect on its territory since April 17 has now been lifted, effective today, April 19, at 12:45 p.m.

The tests carried out on the network over the last 24 hours, in accordance with the rules laid down by the Public Health Department, show that the water is fit for consumption.

**Residents no longer need to boil their water before consumption.**
